Local businesses; community based organisations; marching bands; schools, colleges and educational institutions; classic car clubs; religious organisations and social and hobby groups from the Wingecarribee Shire are encouraged to apply. Other groups will be considered by application.

### HOW TO ENTER

- Read terms and conditions on rear then complete and sign the application form.
- Attach copy of your current public liability insurance.
- Return your application with cheque/money order by **Friday 4th September 2009**.
- You will receive confirmation advising receipt of application.
- Any changes to your application must be submitted in writing to the Tulip Time Parade Sub-Committee by either fax, email or letter.
- Prior to the parade, you will receive written confirmation with information and instructions, parade maps, relevant passes and your parade number.

### SAFETY REGULATIONS

- All participants are responsible for their own personal safety and security. Personal belongings must be in a secure place. All parade entrants should carry water and sun protection (sunscreen, hat & sunglasses).
- All vehicles must be road worthy, registered with compliant greenslip or appropriate permit. Every care should be taken to ensure the safety of the public and any person travelling on or in the vehicle.
- Vehicles and floats must not exceed 4.0m height, 2.2m width. A standard bus is the maximum length for a float (to allow for safe turning). Other vehicles considered by application to the Parade Coordinator.
- Animals are subject to terms and conditions.
- The instructions of Traffic Controllers and the NSW Police must be obeyed at all times. Failure to comply with instructions by officials could result in removal from the parade and exclusion in future parades.

## Risk Management Terms & Conditions

#### WINGECARRIBEE SHIRE COUNCIL TERMS & CONDITIONS:

- All participants in Bowral Tulip Time events must have \$10 million public liability insurance policy and must identify Wingecarribee Shire Council (WSC) as an interested party. A copy of this is to be sent with the Tulip Time application form, along with the risk assessment on your float/parade entry.
- All participants agree to:
  - indemnify WSC against all claims, suits, actions or demands which may result in any injury or other loss sustained by you/anyone participating in Bowral Tulip Time.
  - exonerate WSC from all responsibility and from all loss or injury to any person due to alleged liability in negligence or otherwise.
- Contractors must provide evidence the equipment is properly maintained to the Australian Standards and adequately insured. All contractors must supply a copy of their public liability insurance prior to commencement of works.
- WSC does not accept responsibility for any damage or loss for your business/property or participants.
- Participants are to ensure displays are firmly secured in the event of wind/inclement weather.
- Bowral Tulip Time takes no responsibility for your event or property, only to promote the event within Tulip Time advertising campaigns.
- Procedures of emergency, including contacts, will be sent to you prior to the parade.

#### PARADE TERMS & CONDITIONS:

- All vehicles must be road worthy, registered with compliant greenslip or appropriate permit. Every care should be taken to ensure the safety of public and any person travelling on or in the vehicle. All vehicles involved in the parade must be decorated.
- Maximum float size 4.0m (height) 2.2m (width). Standard bus length maximum length for vehicles. Others by application to the Parade Coordinator.
- Each vehicle must have a Parade Vehicle Pass clearly displayed inside windscreen to access marshalling area.
- Parade marshalling to occur from 1.00pm in Banyette St Carpark Bowral. All participants must be in marshalling area no later than 1.45pm.
- All entries must continue in a forward motion through the parade route. Entries must not stop or cause delay. The instructions of Traffic Control Contractors and the NSW Police must be obeyed. Parade participants must adhere to the parade route and keep within parade time frames.
- Entries must proceed in the order designated by the Parade organiser.
- Alcohol is not to be consumed in the parade marshalling area or during the parade. Any persons found to be under the influence of alcohol or other prohibited substances will be ejected from the parade.
- Floats carrying participants must have appropriate safety rails/restraints fitted.
- Children participating in parade must be accompanied by adults at all times. Recommended ratio 7 children: 1 adult.
- Photographs/film may be taken and used by Tulip Time, the media and others to publicly promote Tulip Time events.
- Suitably experienced adults must accompany animals at all times and will be deemed responsible for the animal and crowd safety during the parade and marshalling. Entrants are responsible for collecting animal waste before, during and after the parade. Tulip Time reserves the right to assess and/or refuse the involvement of animals on a case by case basis.
- Horses must be led by a suitably experienced adult capable of controlling the horse, irrespective of a rider *(exception for NSW Police)*.
- Political propaganda must not be displayed, distributed or disseminated throughout the parade route.
- Entrants are not permitted to distribute or throw giveaways to the audience directly from their vehicle/float. Entrants may hand out giveaways from person to person, on foot, while on the parade route.
- No fireworks, crackers, sparklers or other pyrotechnics, sirens or water pistols are to be used at any time during marshalling or the parade.
- All parade participants must submit a copy of their public liability with their application (minimum of \$10million).
- All applications will be assessed and no application is automatically accepted. Tulip Time reserves the right to exclude any group, individual or organisation from participating in Tulip Time events.
- Failure to comply with terms and conditions may result in removal from the parade and exclusion in future years.
